**CBC Students Raise \$10,000 in one day
for Friends of Kids With Cancer**

The students, staff and faculty raised \$10,000 in one day to benefit the **Friends of Kids With Cancer** non-profit group.

The students raised money as part of the weeklong activities for Catholic Schools Week. The school regularly raises money for the **Friends of Kids With Cancer**, and has become one of the charity's most significant donors in terms of money raised, according to Judy Ciapek, Executive Director of Friends of Kids With Cancer.
